

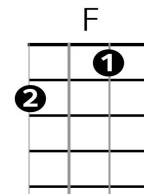
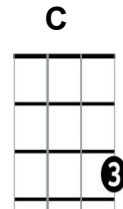
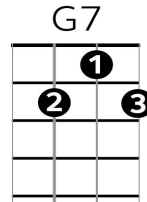
LEAVING ON A JET PLANE
