C G F G Em Am Dm G

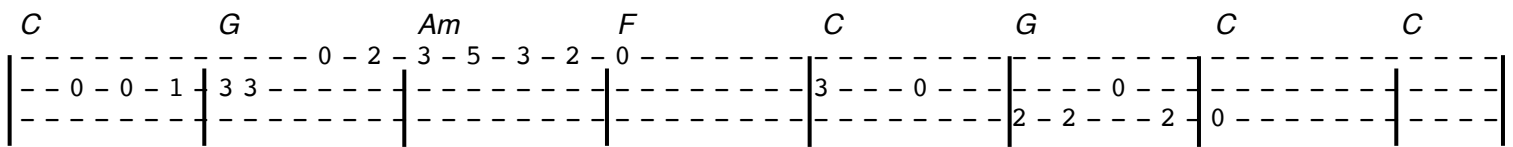
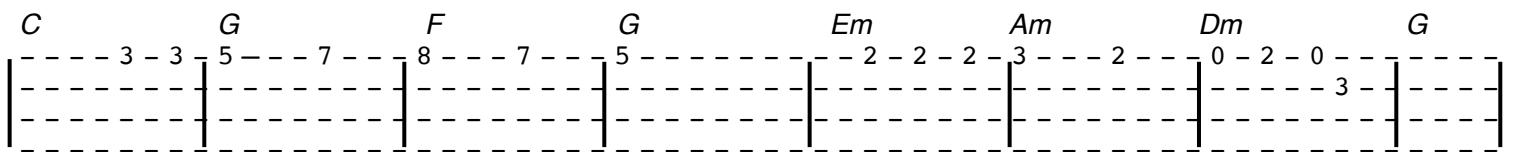
...If I could only have you near... to breathe a sigh or two,
